Treatment for Sexually Abusive Youth

Questions & Answers

Q1: How many new cases do you get per month that require an initial intake and risk assessment?

A1: 1-2 per month

Q2: How many minors will be involved in the program? What is the census?

A2: Currently 9 in West County and 6 in East County (field only; no current groups in JF).

Q3: Would the assessments and treatment be conducted at the Juvenile Justice Complex for minors in custody, or would it be offered as "outpatient" treatment for minors living in the community, or both? If offered as outpatient services, would assessments and treatment (individual therapy and group classes) be done at my private office, or is there an office available for use at the Probation Department, or both?

A3: Both. Assessments and treatment may be required in both the in custody setting or as outpatient in the community. Probation would prefer the provider to have their own facilities/office space. However, group space may be available in a Probation office in Oxnard before 5:30 p.m. There are no Probation offices with room availability in the East County.

Q4: The RFQ indicates that there may be more than one contractor awarded. May I apply for this program as an assessment specialist separately from providing treatment?.

A4: No. VCPA is looking for a provider(s) who can perform both assessment and treatment. The potential multiple awards are based mainly on the ability to provide services in different locations.

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
